Shot of girl sitting. Screen begins to zoom in on her.

GIRL Oh, hey there! What's wrong? You don't look too happy.

Girl gets up and starts walking towards the 'camera'.

## GIRL

Well, I know what's got me down. Boys. It's like nothing ever goes right with them! You say one thing they do another. I mean are we speaking different languages here?

Girl turns away from camera, and puts her hand on her chin in a thinking position.

GIRL

Huh, I guess I never thought of that before. Maybe we ARE speaking different languages.

Girl walks off stage. Girl comes back onstage farther away from the camera, struggling with pulling onstage a chalkboard.

GIRL Okay, check this out. Here's an example.

Girl, now wearing glasses and holding a pointer stick, points to the chalkboard with a drawn picture of a girl and boy. Camera zooms in on chalkboard. Drawn figures begin to move on the chalkboard.

## GIRL

(Narrating) This Jane and John. They're going to see a movie. They walk up to the counter to purchase their tickets. John says, "Two please." Jane says, "Oh that's alright, you don't have to buy my ticket!" Which is a polite thing to suggest. John says, "Oh alright, one then please." Look at Jane she's just disgusted! Obviously, when the girl suggests paying she doesn't actually mean she wants to pay, right?

Camera zooms out back to girl standing next to chalkboard. Girl takes off glasses.

GIRL

This is just one example of how annoy-

A boy-walking bye cuts off girl.

## BOY

Hey!

Girl waves at boy, and gets a huge smile on her face.

GIRL What was I saying? Oh right. Boys being annoying. (Hurried speech) Well I guess that's just one of life's battles. Can't win them all!

Girl runs offstage towards boy.
