How To Take & Good Portrait

A good portrait draws attention to the subject. This is achieved by a shallow depth of field, composition, color, and lighting.

You should take around 50 photos. Try to capture the in-between moments.

Even lighting takes your portrait to the next level.

When it's time to shoot put your camera in aperture priority mode. Aperture= f/1.8 - f/2. Shutter speed=1/100th of sec ISO=low

## Engage with your subject

...

You want your camera to be level or slightly above the model's eyeline. Do not shoot from a low angle.

When framing your shot don't cut off any of the model's limbs.
