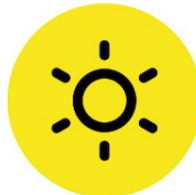

Editing Landscape Photography



Picking a photo

Picking the right photo is essential creating the perfect end product. You want to pick a good photo that you can enhance rather than a bad photo that you have to fix.



Editing the photo

The first things you want to edit are exposure and white balance. Both of these will set the tone for the photo. There are several adjustments that can be made next. The main things you want to focus on are the saturation and hue of colors. You also want to edit for contrast: Emphasis shadows and highlights.



Final Touches

After you finish editing you want to go back to the exposure, clarity, saturation and vibrance. After making other adjustments you may want to change these to enhance the photo better. You should also look out for things that you missed when you shot the photo. People in the background, things you don't want in the photo, etc.
