


Screenplay Format And Usage

1-Action Lines (Big Print): These are the directions the cast and crew follow. For example, what the mood and tone of the scene is. Make sure to be specific because your cast and crew aren't mind readers, and they will probably not know exactly how the shot is visualized in your story. Also lets you know the time and place you are supposed to be filming.

2-Character name

3-Parenteticals : Small actions usually during or between dialogue for the actors to follow

4-Transitions : Used by post production crew mainly when editing. Telling them how to transition between scenes. It also provides itself as a marker for when the scene ends and a new one is beginning.
